It is our mission to help women and children in Waukesha County move beyond their individual challenges to live life more fully. We support organizations that provide programs and services for women, children, and families to lead a better quality of life. Our members dedicate a tremendous amount of time and talent to raise funds for and volunteer at many worthwhile organizations.

We are pleased to share that this is our thirteenth year of offering scholarships to deserving young women in our communities who share our mission and goals. The intention of these scholarships is to impact the lives of young women who readily avail themselves to their communities in an effort to make a positive difference. Attached is the VSCP Scholarship Application form. The VSCP will award three non-renewal \$1500 scholarships to high school senior women who attend one of the following high schools:

- Arrowhead
- Kettle Moraine
- Pewaukee

Eligibility guidelines and overview:

- 1. The scholarships will go to high school senior women; VSCP is a women's service organization.
- 2. VSCP awards the scholarships on a one-time, non-renewal basis.
- 3. The awards, totaling \$4,500 each year, will most likely be divided by \$1,500 to each school; however VSCP reserves the right to alter the distribution at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, e.g., based on merit or lack of applicants from a school.
- 4. Applicants must have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0.
- 5. Applicants must show an interest in pursuing a 4-year degree that is service-oriented (e.g., healthcare, education, non-profit, or social work).
- 6. VSCP will award the scholarships at its discretion based on answers to the essays, volunteer activities, and chosen career path.
